

Patron Code of Conduct

Gooding Public Library

To ensure that all visitors of the Gooding Public Library have access to resources and services of the library, the board of trustees has adopted the following guidelines for behavior. Violation of these guidelines may result in the loss of library privileges as well as the right to be in the library building.

All patrons are required to respect others and the library staff. Behavior that may interfere with library services, employees, or other visitors is forbidden. This behavior includes but is not limited to:

1. Use of profane, obscene or abusive language or acts.
2. Possession or use of alcohol or illegal drugs.
3. Intoxication
4. Mutilation, defacement or theft of library property
5. Use of furniture or facilities in a manner in which they were not designed.
6. Sleeping
7. Harassing or threatening of others.
8. Selling, soliciting or mass distribution of materials.
9. Smoking or e-cigarettes
10. Any conduct that disrupts the normal business of the library.

Please keep the volume of your voice low as to not disturb others.

Animals other than those required for programs, law enforcement or a service animal are not permitted in the library.

All briefcases, handbags, packages, overcoats, backpacks, and shopping bags may be subjects to inspection.

Violation of local, state or federal law will be reported to the proper authorities
