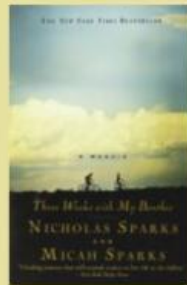

Three Weeks With My Brother, by Nicholas & Micah Sparks



In January 2003, Nicholas Sparks and his brother Micah set off on a 3-week global trip to reflect that at the ages 37 and 38 respectively, they were the sole surviving members of their family. Their voyage included visiting the lost city of Machu Picchu and Easter Island, then onto Ayers Rock in the Australian outback. They further journeyed across the vast Indian subcontinent. Their tale recalls their rambunctious childhood adventures and shared tragedies that tested their faith. In the process, they learned truths about loss, love and hope.

Dead Wake: The Last Crossing of the Lusitania, by Erik Larson



In this story of the sinking of the Lusitania, Larson switches between hunter and hunted while painting a larger portrait of American at the height of the Progressive Era. Full of glamour, mystery and suspense, *Dead Wake* brings to life a cast of evocative characters, and it captures the sheer drama and emotional power of a disaster that helped place American on the road to war.

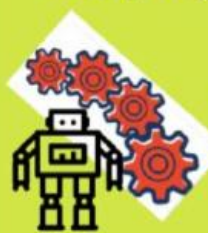

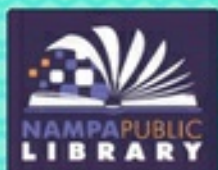
