

Amoral Tuttle Public Library Policy

Policy Violation

The Board of Trustees of the Amoral Tuttle Public Library delegates to the Director the authority to enforce all policy, including the authority to suspend the library privileges of individuals who violate policy.

Such limitation or revocation shall be effective upon the patron receiving a verbal and/or written notification. A patron whose privilege(s) has been limited or revoked may appeal the limitation or revocation of the privilege(s) by filing a written appeal with the Director within ten (10) days from the date of the issuance of the written revocation.

Patrons have the right to request a Board review of any suspension that exceeds thirty days. The Board of Trustees decision is final.

The patron whose privilege(s) has been limited or revoked shall attend a meeting with the Director to review the Patron Behavior Policy before his privilege(s) may be reinstated.
